Sanction: Meet held under the Sanction of USA Swimming Inc., Sanction #UT10-11

“In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that United States Swimming (USA) shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event” Whether entries are submitted electronically or on paper, by the action of entering the swimmer in the meet the submitter whether the swimmer, coach, parent or team representative, certifies that the swimmer is a registered member of USA Swimming and that all times stated in/on the entry are true and correct. The submitter further assumes responsibility for any false or incorrect times, and understands that all listed entry times are subject to Utah Swimming Time Verification Procedures, and that a fine of \$20.00 shall be paid to Utah Swimming, Inc. for each incorrect time, unless corrected before the entry deadline. It is understood that an automatic call before the review section shall be the result for a third entry time that cannot be verified. The submitter further agrees that a penalty of \$100.00 shall be assessed to anyone entering a swimmer in a meet sanctioned by Utah Swimming, Inc. who is not registered with USA Swimming at the time of entry, upon it being proven that the swimmer was not so registered.

Rules: 2009 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern the meet.

Age: Swimmer's age as of January 9, 2010 will determine the age for the meet.

Eligibility: Open to all swimmers currently 2010 registered with USA Swimming

Individual Entry Limit: Four (4) individual events.

Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$13. Entry fees are non-refundable and are due **before** the start of the meet. Fees must be paid before the scratch deadline of the meet or the swimmers will be scratched. Checks may be delivered at the meet or sent to the following: Eagle Aquatic Team, PO Box 9056, Salt Lake City, UT 84109. Please make one entry check to EAT.

Entry Deadline & Limits: All entries must be received by Nancy Finley by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, January 6th, 2010. Late entries and additional entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director. *The meet will be limited in swimmers to adhere to the four (4) hour rule (applies to 12 & Under).* Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date & time of email for electronic entries until the four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. The Meet Director will produce a Session Report to determine when to close the meet. No team will be split, unless they express that desire. All correspondence must include an email address & phone # so that Teams can be notified if their entries were not accepted because of the 4 hour rule.

Entries: Entries are not deemed valid and will not be processed until Nancy Finley has received: (a) an electronic Hy-Tek Meet Entry file delivered by an email attachment; and (b) an email confirmation of receipt of entry. A

mandatory scratch down may apply to this meet as per the USA Rules and Regulations 205.31F. Checks will be returned. Teams not accepted will be notified by phone or email. No time trial entries.

Entry Confirmation: An email attachment of your teams Hy-Tek Meet Manager Entry List Report will be returned to each team to verify entries. It is up to each team to verify entry delivery of entries.

Results: Results will be posted and emailed after the meet.

Awards: Event ribbons for 1-6th place will be given.

Check-In: A NEGATIVE CHECK-IN WILL BE USED – Coaches or a team representative need only declare scratched and no-shows with the Clerk of Course at least 30 minutes prior to the starting time of the meet each day. No deck entries will be accepted.

Scratches: Only coaches may scratch a swimmer from an event. Scratches must be reported at least 30 minutes before the event is to be swum. Any swimmer missing an event will be listed as a no show (ns) for that event and will not be allowed to swim that event, however, they will not be scratched from their subsequent events.

Safety Rules: Utah Swimming Safety Procedures will be in forced during this meet.

Warm-Ups: All Warm-ups must be under the supervision of a USA coach or official. Coaches have the responsibility of insuring that all their swimmers are instructed in warm-up rules and all their swimmers are instructed in warm-up rules and that swimmers follow all Utah Swimming Rules.

Swimmers must enter the water by walking down the steps, or from a sitting position from the ends or sides of the pool.

All Lanes of the pool will be used for circle swimming only (no equipment may be used). During the last 15 minutes, lane 2 and 5 are sprint lanes with dive start only.

Unaccompanied Swimmers: As per USA Swimming rule 202.3.2, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming Member coach during warm up, competition, and warm down. If you do not have a coach with you, please check in with the meet director or referee before entering the pool. A coach will be assigned to you.

Timers: All teams participating in the meet will be responsible for providing timers. Lane assignments will be posted.

Concessions: Concessions will not be available during the meet.
